I am here to testify in opposition to LD 1343 An Act to Protect the Reproductive Freedom of Maine People by Preempting the Field of Abortion Regulation - *Rep. Laura Supica of Bangor*

The religion of abortion is a strong draw to many. It pays well. It causes people elected to protect citizens to draft a law that says abortion buildings do not have to get inspected like organizations and fields that really do healthcare. The religion holds back from many the facts that abortions <u>can cause</u> mental health issues, end the ability to have a baby, can cause suicidal thoughts, even can cause a women's death.
