Testimony of Senator Lisa Keim before the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry

**LD 2033, Resolve, Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to Convey a Parcel of Land in the Town of Woodstock**

January 3, 2024

Good afternoon, Senator Ingwersen, Representative Pluecker, and honorable members of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. I am Lisa Keim, and I proudly represent the citizens of Senate District 19, which includes much of Northern Oxford County and Southern Franklin County. I am here to present LD 2033, "Resolve, Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to Convey a Parcel of Land in the Town of Woodstock."

Late last year, the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry asked me to be the sponsor of legislation they had drafted which would allow the sale of 0.34 acres of Public Reserved Land in the Town of Woodstock at fair market value. For an unknown reason, this detached lot was included in the recent sale of a larger conservation area to the Department.

From my communications with the Town Manager, I understand that the Town of Woodstock has no objections to this proposal. Proceeds from the sale will be used to acquire conservation lands elsewhere in the county.
