Testimony of Rep. Sally Cluchey presenting
LD 2061 Resolve, Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to Convey Peacock Beach State Park to the Town of Richmond
Before the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture Conservation and Forestry

Good afternoon, Senator Ingwersen, Representative Pluecker and esteemed members of the Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry Committee. My name is Sally Cluchey, and I proudly represent House District 52, which includes the communities of Bowdoinham, Bowdoin and Richmond. I am here today to present LD 2061, *A Resolve, Authorizing the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands to Convey Peacock Beach State Park to the Town of Richmond*.

Peacock Beach is a quaint and quiet 32-acre waterfront park that is extensively frequented by our local community, especially in the summer months. The town of Richmond has been actively managing that property under a 25-year lease with the state and is interested in making improvements to the park. Owning, rather than leasing the park will make it far easier for the Town to make those improvements. Both the State and the Town are in agreement that this arrangement makes good sense.
