"An Act to Make Technical Updates to the Maine Uniform Securities Act"

Before the Joint Standing Committee on Health Coverage, Insurance and Financial Services January 9, 2024 at 1:00 p.m.

Senator Bailey, Representative Perry, distinguished members of the Committee, good afternoon. My name is Jesse Devine, and I am the Administrator of the Office of Securities. I am here to testify in support of LD 2020, An Act to Make Technical Updates to the Maine Uniform Securities Act. I would like to thank Senator Bailey for her willingness to put the bill forward for the Committee's consideration.

The Maine Uniform Securities Act ("Maine Act"), which I administer and enforce, was enacted effective December 31, 2005. The Maine Act, with some modifications, represents enactment of the Uniform Securities Act of 2002 ("Uniform Act"), a model act approved by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws.

Given the dual federal and state regulatory structure for the securities industry, several provisions in the Maine Act refer to relevant federal laws and

Additionally, the bill updates a dollar amount derived from federal law and corrects a citation error carried over from an error in the Uniform Act.

You may see bills like this in the future as staff will conduct regular reviews of the Maine Act to assure updates to references to federal laws and regulations are presented to you as necessary.
