On behalf of the groups signed below, we urge you to pass National Popular Vote in Maine during the upcoming legislative session and make it a priority of your policy agenda.

For too long, action on this important election reform has been stalled and stymied despite bipartisan support.

Maine now has an unprecedented opportunity to act on this important proposal so we can join the 16 other states and the District of Columbia that already have passed National Popular Vote into law.

We can change that by enacting National Popular Vote, which will also make our government more responsive, accountable, and answer to ALL Maine citizens.


