This bill reduces the time and resources needed to prepare a comprehensive plan, and allows municipalities to direct their resources to visioning and implementation and it recognizes that implementation is the most challenging and enduring part of the comprehensive planning process, and provides an updated and more robust set of potential implementation strategies that reflect current best practices.

It also provides opportunities for the state and regional planning organizations to support municipalities through updated tools and technical support.

It is for these reasons alone that I would hope for the passage of LD1976 as I feel this is a step forward to helping Maine's housing crisis and I hope that you all feel the same.
