

This Rural Economic TOOL that works well and is essential to the survival of all of Maine's Agriculture!

Thank you for recognizing the need for Maine's Dairy Industry to stay strong, for many reasons including wide open spaces and vacationland opportunities.

The Maine Dairy Industry is a backbone that provides the infrastructure necessary for other local and smaller agriculture to flourish.

It also represents thousands of jobs for Maine people and millions of dollars to Maine's economy.

Maine Dairy... is MAINE! With out it...it's just not going to BE Maine!

Our farm had a fire before Christmas and it stopped our ability to milk our cows.
