Re: L.D. 1793, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services to Contract for Discounted Insulin Manufactured and Distributed by Civica Rx", 131st Second Regular Session

Dear Senator Bailey, Representative Perry, and Members of the Committee:

The Bureau takes no position on L.D. 1793, nor its proposed amendment. The purpose of this letter is to raise a concern that the Bureau has about language in the amendment.

Section 4 of the bill creates a new section in the Health Plan Improvement Act¹, section 4317-C, regarding coverage for prescription insulin drugs. In the last sentence of subsection 2-A, it is unclear whether the Superintendent of Insurance must make a determination on the adequacy of the data the carrier submits to the Bureau to demonstrate that another insulin drug has a lower net cost than the one already on its formulary. If the Superintendent must analyze this data and approve a carrier's submission, this analysis could require a fiscal note as the Bureau of Insurance does not have the necessary expertise in-house. On the other hand, if the submitted data does not require an analysis, no fiscal note will be required.
