Senator Bailey, Representative Perry, and members of the Legislative Health Coverage, Insurance and Financial Services Committee, my name is Carol Bailey, I reside in Minot, ME. I am here to testify against LD 227, An Act Regarding Health Care in the State.

I am a Christian, a mother, a grandmother, and a retired registered school nurse. I value the lives of children and their right to an unhindered childhood, free of fear, sexual interference and evil.

LD 227 would open the borders of Maine to people from every state in the union, (sounds like the opening of our southern border, that has not turned out well especially for children and women.) Abortion, trafficking children, mutilating the bodies of children, allowing illegal activity to go unchecked by police and our justice system, all these are abhorrent to God and not representative of my personal value or the values of many Maine citizens. These activities spell death, loss, separation of families, physical and emotional pain not life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

That money would better be spent on our Maine veterans, the homeless and helping children understand their gender questions. With all due respect LD 227 is purely evil and appeals to the lowest of human nature. It does not protect children or women. This bill will divide families, create hostility and divisions, and will not benefit Maine or its citizens. Please vote against this legislation and work to bring peace, reconciliation, and sanity to the governing of Maine.
