Testimony of Frank Schutte LD227

Senator Bailey, Representative Perry and members of the Committee on Health Coverage and Financial Services.

My name is Frank Schutte and i stand opposed to LD227. I am a resident of Wiscasset. I have 3 adult children and a 17yr old still at home. 2 of my children we adopted from the state of Maine and 1 of my children has high functioning Autism. To say the least our family has seen very difficult times in trying to raise these kids to be healthy and well adjusted. We have lived their struggles with them.

Being people of faith and seeing the complete disregard for our Constitutional rights of freedom of religion that LD227 brings to the table is very concerning.

The most concerning issue that it brings to the table is stripping not only Maine parents of their authority to make the best decisions for their own children, but the rights of parents nation wide. It is gross overreach that kids could be taken from other states without parental permission with the aid of the State of Maine. It is condoning kidnapping.

It is accepted science that humans do not have full capacity to make unemotional decisions vs. factual decisions until well into their twenties. If your 12, 13, 14, year old came home and said she was going to marry her boyfriend now, you would lovingly deny them that request because while understanding that in their mind they truly believe they are in love, you recognise that they are being ruled by their emotions and haven't experienced enough life to make such a profound decision.
