The baseline budget for the Energy Rate Relief Fund can be found on page A-190. This Other Special Revenue account was established to accept funds from the Maine Jobs and Recovery Program when the program was active. The baseline allocation in this inactive account exists as a placeholder only. There are no new initiatives for this program.

OFFICE OF BROADBAND DEVELOPMENT

By statute, the Office of Broadband Development provides assistance to the ConnectMaine Authority Board in the administration and financial assistance to communities for expanding broadband and services. As you have just heard from Nick Battista, ConnectMaine entered into a Memorandum of Understanding that designates that the Maine Connectivity Authority will execute on behalf of ConnectMaine at this time. This collaboration, which includes the work previously done by the Office of Broadband, ensures operations are streamlined and resources are maximized in the deployment of broadband infrastructure.

The **baseline budget** request for the Office of Broadband Development may be found on **page A-196.** This account has two unfunded positions. The All Other allocation exists as a place holder only as there are no anticipated revenues or cash in this account. It is unclear whether there will be a role for the Office of Broadband Development in the future so for now, we would like to keep the account active but unfunded. **There are no initiatives for this program.**
