## **LD 110, An Act to Require Reporting on the Expenditure of Opioid Settlement Funds by Certain Municipalities and County Governments**

*Before the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services*

Good afternoon, Senator Ingwersen, Representative Meyer and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. My name is Michael Brennan, and I represent House District 115, which includes a portion of Portland.

Again, I want to thank my House colleague for reading this testimony and presenting LD 110 on my behalf. I apologize that I cannot be with you all in person today.

As you know, a portion of the opioid settlement funds are allocated to local governments. This bill is very simple and straightforward. It requires that an annual report be submitted to the Attorney General's office, detailing the amount of these funds received and how they were utilized to address substance use issues in their communities. If passed, the first report must be submitted by January 15, 2026.

This committee is quite familiar with the settlement fund, and I am sure members are committed to ensuring appropriate expenditures of the funds.
