Before my husband and I got married, we called social security and they said roughly I would make \$200 a month. But when we got married we called social security again and that was not the case. They said I would be getting \$6.75 a month. Time went on and I would get SSI letters in the mail saying I would have to pay things back because they would pay me too much- and that was annoying.

I should not be penalized because I wanted to get married to my best friend. It's unfair to get penalized because when I first heard that I was getting \$6.75 a month, I felt like a burden on my husband and my family members. I would have to rely on them to pay for clothes, hygiene products, food, it's just not fair for them to always have to pay for me.

We deserve to be heard like anyone else and to have the same respect of everyone else. We should have the opportunity to get married and have a life.
