Testimony of Senator Donna Bailey introducing

LD 672, Resolve, to Rename Salmon Falls Bridge in Buxton the Salmon Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge

Before the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation Tuesday, March 25, 2025

Senator Nangle, Representative Crafts, and Esteemed Members of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation, my name is Donna Bailey, and I proudly represent Senate District 31, which includes Buxton, Old Orchard Beach, and Saco. Today, I am pleased to introduce my bill <u>LD 672</u>, "Resolve, to Rename Salmon Falls Bridge in Buxton the Salmon Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge." It directs the Department of Transportation to rename Salmon Falls Bridge in Buxton and Hollis the Salmon Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge.

In the days leading up to cloture, the Hon. Ben Chipman, my former Senate colleague who used to be the Chair of this committee, approached me and told me the story of Calista Cross. I'm sure that many of you are familiar with Calista and her heroic efforts to rename bridges and recognize veterans across Maine. You've likely already worked on several of her bridge renaming bills this session.

With LD 672, we have the opportunity to rename another bridge: the Salmon Falls Bridge in Buxton and Hollis. As the State Senator representing Buxton, I am honored to sponsor this bill. Believe it or not, prior to this year, I had never renamed a bridge. Now, I'm involved with renaming three: The Captain Christopher S. Cash Memorial Bridge in Old Orchard Beach and Saco, the General Wallace H. Nutting Memorial Bridge in Biddeford and Saco, and – with your support – the Salmon Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge in Buxton and Hollis.

I am not sure if Calista will be present today. When I reached out to her, she said that she has to monitor the weather before she considers making the trip to the State House. Regardless, I am including the letters of support, which Calista worked on, from both Buxton and Hollis to rename the Salmon Falls Bridge.

As lawmakers, we serve on different committees and work on many bills. With this particular one, I am pleased to help honor Maine's veterans. Whether residents or visitors, people who see these bridge names will remember the brave men and women who served in the armed forces. In this way, we will not forget their patriotism and sacrifice. We can demonstrate our gratitude for their efforts to protect our freedoms and rights.
