

Testimony Block 1, March 26th, 2025

Good day, my name is Gregory Hunnewell from Belgrade Lakes, and I would like to thank you for the opportunity to testify today.

LD 677, This is a copy of last year's bill that was Vetoed by Governor Mills, as far as I am concerned this was one and done. I urge you to vote (OUGHT NOT TO PASS).

LD 953, An act to change the definition of a Machine Gun, I my opinion this is a good thing and should be voted as (Ought to Pass).

LD 1109 An Act to Reduce Gun Violence Casualties in Maine by Prohibiting the Possession of Large Capacity Ammunition Feeding Devices. This bill is nothing but an end around for the purpose of Banning and making obsolete as many firearms as you possibly can. There is nothing about Safety in this bill, it puts law abiding people at great risk to harm by not allowing us a level playing field against those who may wish to harm us, the criminals are not going to abide by these rules, Not all firearms have a 10 round magazine available for purchase thus making them obsolete, and in addition to that most .22 Long Rifle firearms with a Tubular Magazine can hold more than 10 rounds and to my knowledge can not be made to hold less, this would mean that after 180 days that the gun would have to be destroyed as the magazine is part of the gun. You are dangerously playing politics with our lives and our property. I urge you to vote as OUGHT NOT TO PASS.

LD 1126 An Act Requiring Serial Numbers on Firearms and Prohibiting Undetectable Firearms, this bill is not needed, and I urge you to vote it as OUGHT NOT PASS. I Sincerely Thank You for Your Time
