Testimony on

L.D. 1050, "An Act to Allow an Adult Hunter to Transfer That Hunter's Antlerless Deer Permit to a Junior Hunter"

Presented by Representative David C. Woodsome District 139

Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Committee Monday, March 31, 2025

Good afternoon, Senator Baldacci, Representative Roberts, and fellow members of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife:

I am State Representative David C. Woodsome, and I proudly represent District 139, Limerick, Parsonsfield, and a portion of Waterboro. It is an honor to appear before you today for the purpose of introducing L.D. 1050, "An Act to Allow an Adult Hunter to Transfer That Hunter's Antlerless Deer Permit to a Junior Hunter."

In preparing today's presentation, an oversight came to my attention in the actual title of the bill. It should read and address "Antlered Deer Permit," not "Antlerless Deer Permit."

Accordingly, my proposal seeks to allow a person who is 18 years of age or older, and in the possession of a valid "antlered" deer permit, to transfer that permit to a person with a valid junior hunting license. The process in which to transfer the permit is likewise established in the bills language.

It should also be noted that the transferor may not hunt "antlered" deer, but must supervise the junior hunter while he/she is hunting.

Thank you for your consideration. I will be happy to address any questions members may have at this time pertaining to my rationale for proposing this legislation.
