I'm writing to express my strong support for LD 182: *An Act to Require the Department of Health and Human Services to Establish MaineCare Reimbursement Rates for the Maine Veterans' Homes on a Per Resident Basis.*

Life at MVH has brought me peace of mind. There is always something to do, and the people who care for us are nothing short of angels. I no longer have to worry about the things I used to when living on my own. The food is excellent, and the activities keep us engaged and moving. The staff are warm, outgoing, and truly make this place feel like home. My entire family is on a first-name basis with the staff, which says a lot about the sense of community here.

This level of care, however, depends on reliable and adequate funding. Currently, MaineCare does not fully cover the cost of caring for each resident. LD 182 would help ensure that MVH can continue delivering the high-quality care we depend on, retain its dedicated staff, and remain accessible to Veterans throughout Maine.

This issue means a great deal to me, and I respectfully urge your support for LD 182 to help preserve the Homes that serve those who have served.
