My name is Nancy Charlebois and my husband and I own one rental unit in Portland.

We oppose LD1534 because:

Revoking state law on no-cause evictions and imposing rent controls disproportionately affect small landlords like us . Without the option to remove problematic tenants, we may be forced to retain those who create hostile or unsafe environments - putting respectful tenants at risk and us, especially small property owners, to costly and prolonged legal battles - OR to exit the market entirely, worsening Maine's housing crisis.

These laws discourage new housing development, which Maine desperately needs, and reduces property values. In rent-controlled Portland, multi-unit property values have significantly declined as a direct result of rent stabilization.

Rent stabilization lowers property values, reducing property tax revenue and shifting the burden to single-family homeowners, including the elderly and struggling families. It also disproportionately harms small landlords, who often lack the financial cushion to absorb mandated rent caps and rising costs.
