

Testimony of Maine Conservation Voters

"An Act to Require Disclosure of Campaign Funding Sources"

Before the Veterans and Legal Affairs Committee

Senator Hickman, Representative Supica, and distinguished members of the Veterans and Legal Affairs Committee.

My name is Nick Janzen, Director of Policy and Partnerships at Maine Conservation Voters, a state-wide non-profit organization with more than 13,000 members and supporters devoted to building an inclusive democracy and making conservation and climate action a political priority.

I'm here to testify in proud support of LD 1666, "An Act to Include in the Ranked-choice Election Method for General and Special Elections the Offices of Governor, State Senator and State Representative and to Make Other Related Changes." At MCV, we believe that you can't have a healthy environment without a healthy democracy. That's why we support measures to make our democratic institutions more accessible and responsive to Maine people. Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) is a common sense, non-partisan form of elections designed to maximize voter choice at the ballot. The more meaningful options voters have to express their preference for candidates who will champion our climate and environment, the better off our world will be. A poll from the 2024 election shows that Maine voters overwhelmingly support RCV and find it easy to use. The time is long past to standardize the form of Maine elections as voters intended when they adopted RCV in 2016.

This bill returns elections for governor and state legislature to the RCV statute and conforms the statute with the Maine Constitution's plurality provisions.<sup>2</sup> It does this by more clearly demonstrating that a voter expresses preferences when ranking candidates on their ballot and that a vote is not tallied until election officials have taken all of a voter's preferences into account.

The purpose of the Constitution's plurality provisions is to avoid the need for the Legislature to select the winner of an election. On several occasions during the 1800s, the Legislature decided

elections where no candidate received a majority of the votes. At times, they selected candidates who didn't even receive the most votes. This political history culminated with the Maine Capitol Riot of 1880 and the later adoption of the plurality requirements. The point was to improve the system so that people, not other elected officials, could directly elect their governor and representatives.

This bill makes RCV consistent with both the spirit and the letter of the Constitution. It will result in the election of gubernatorial and state legislative candidates who receive the most votes, without requiring a majority, and it does so directly at the ballot, not in the State House, assuring voter confidence in the political system.

The bill is also consistent with the Constitution's text. In 2020 the Alaska Supreme Court held that that state's RCV statute is consistent with its constitutional plurality requirement, both of which are virtually identical to Maine's.<sup>3</sup> The Alaska Supreme Court understood that a vote is not determined until after the final round of tabulation.

In contrast, the Justices of the Maine Supreme Court determined in their 2017 solemn occasion that a vote was final after the first round of voting, without pointing to anything in the Constitution or the statute that required them to reach that decision, and that RCV would deny candidates who won this "first plurality."

LD 1666 clarifies that a vote is only determined after the final round of tabulation. There is no first plurality, there is only the plurality or the majority that exists after the final tabulation, and it is, therefore, consistent with the constitution.

For these reasons, MCV, along with our undersigned members, urge you to vote "ought to pass" on LD 1666.
