Testimony of Rep. Flavia DeBrito introducing LD 1566, An Act to Provide Compensation to Individuals with Lived Experience Serving on Advisory Boards, Commissions, Councils and Similar Groups

Before the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government

Today, you will hear the testimony of important voices in our community who sit on board advisory panels, committees and more. They will tell their stories of how important LD 1566 is to them.

I am eager to engage in meaningful discussions with all of you regarding the importance of this bill and the positive impact it can have on individuals with lived experience seeking to contribute to advisory boards.
