Thank you for the opportunity to testify today in support of LD 843. The Office encourages the continued support for Maine's Consumer Assistance Program, which plays a critical role in assisting consumers in navigating the complexities of the health care system.

During both of the public hearings the Office of Affordable Health Care has held since our inception, we heard from community members about difficulty navigating coverage options and use of their insurance. A theme in input we receive is that patients often end up caught in the middle of disputes between carriers and providers about billing, and the Consumer Assistance Program is uniquely positioned to assist them in determining a path forward. The program is particularly valuable in its ability to serve people across coverage types and throughout the continuum of needs, from help with enrollment to assistance with claims denials and appeals.

While we work together to improve the simplicity and efficiency of the health care system in Maine, it is important to continue to provide this critical resource for Maine people.
