OUR MISSION IN ACTION

- Coalition partner and instructors for "Aquaculture in Shared Waters", a no-cost training offered to Maine fishermen and entrepreneurs seeking to build resilient businesses and diversify coastal opportunities through sea-farming
- Developed the **nation's first scallop aquaculture cultivation project**, engaging shellfish growers in Maine with farmers in Aomori & Hokkaido, Japan and purchasing customized equipment to be shared among growers to advance the sector
- Led **tech transfer trips abroad**, bringing Maine growers to Japan, South Korea, France and Atlantic Canda to experience first-hand foreign operations in scallop and kelp farming and markets
- Designed and administered the **nation's first Working Waterfront Access Protection Program**, with 30 working waterfront properties protected, comprising 8,725 feet of Maine shoreline, with a full market value of \$26 million
