I am Lynn Grotte, a voter from Unity, I will testify in support of LD1259 An Act to Enhance Public Safety by Defining the Relationship Between Local and Federal Law Enforcement and in support for LD1971 An Act to Protect Workers in this State by Clarifying the Relationship of State and Local law enforcement Agencies with Federal Immigration Authorities Please, vote ought to pass.

I am here to relate to an anecdote that illustrates what is actually happening. Two residents of my town were recently abducted by ICE. They are both working men with current green cards. They were pulled over by local police for driving 8 mph over the speed limit. Instead of ticketing them the local police detained them, likely an act of racial profiling, and summoned ICE. The men were taken into custody and as far as I know await a hearing in an ICE prison in Massachusetts. Their passenger, the wife of one, who is a young vulnerable woman, and who is not fluent in English yet, was left alone at night in the forest beside a road. Their teenage sons were home alone.

To illustrate that our community is supportive of their release I will say that near \$200K dollars has been quickly raised to help our neighbors.

This kind of overreach by law enforcement makes all of us unsafe!
