My name is Polly Haight Frawley, I live in Cumberland. Senator Carney, Representative Kuhn, and esteemed members of the committee, I respectfully testify in support of LD 1378: An Act to Protect Maine Communities by Enacting the Extreme Risk Protection Order Act.

I urge you to vote in favor of this proposal as written.

First, it provides an additional tool that can supplement our current yellow flag law. Under current law, family members do not have the ability to directly seek help for their loved one in crisis. The yellow flag law requires too many steps and thus is not efficient and it relies on law enforcement who are already understaffed, overly taxed in terms of efforts, under budgeted and do not have mental health training. It is not used consistently across the state.

Firearms are the highest cause of death in children from ages 1 to 17.
