*Testimony of Senator Donna Bailey introducing*  
**LD 1998, An Act to Authorize Registration of Certain Cash-Dispensing  
Machines Through the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System and Registry  
and to Limit the Use of Certain Cash-Dispensing Machines as Virtual  
Currency Kiosks**

Good afternoon, Representative Mathieson and colleagues on the Committee on Health Coverage, Insurance, and Financial Services. As you know, I am Senator Donna Bailey, representing Senate District 31, which includes Buxton, Old Orchard Beach, and Saco. I am pleased to be here today as the sponsor of the Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection's bill LD 1998, "**An Act to Authorize Registration of Certain Cash-Dispensing Machines through the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System and Registry and to Limit the use of Certain Cash-Dispensing Machines as Virtual Currency Kiosks.**"

The Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection ("BCCP") currently registers non-bank atm cash dispensing machines. BCCP is requesting legislation that will allow it to use NMLS for registration purposes. Using NMLS will streamline the registration process and will make the process more user friendly. It also clarifies that, if a cash-dispensing machine performs functions in addition to cash-dispensing, other laws may apply.
