*Testimony of Representative Morgan Rielly introducing*

**LD 2025, An Act to Create a Limited-purpose License for Aquaculture  
Nursery and Husbandry Activities and to Clarify the Aquaculture Lease  
Amendment Process**

*Before the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources*

Good morning, Senator Tepler, Representative Hepler and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources. I am Morgan Rielly and I represent House District 127, which includes part of Westbrook. Thank you for the opportunity to introduce, on behalf of the Department of Marine Resources (DMR), **LD 2025, An Act to Create a Limited-purpose License for Aquaculture Nursery and Husbandry Activities and to Clarify the Aquaculture Lease Amendment Process**.

Last year I introduced **LD 1596** to help address the red tape facing our sea farmers regarding the amendment process. We turned that bill into a study in order to give the Aquaculture Advisory Council and DMR time to come to a consensus on how to address many of the issues brought up in the public hearing, while maintaining the high environmental and public trust standards Maine is known for. **LD 2025** embodies the spirit of **LD 1596** and has the consensus of the department and the council.

In short summary, this bill as currently written aims to achieve two outcomes:

1. Establish a limited-purpose aquaculture license that allows for nursery and husbandry activities in coastal waters under specified conditions; and
2. Clarify and modernize the process for amending aquaculture leases, making it more transparent and practical for sea farmers to responsibly add species, gear, equipment or structures.

While I was not a member of Aquaculture Advisory Council meetings, DMR and the council members present can provide background on the specifics of the bill and how they came to the language in it.
