SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1073, L. D. 686, "Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Change the Term of Office of Treasurer of State."

Amend said Resolve by striking out the title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Remove the Provision That the Treasurer Shall Not Be Eligible More Than Six Years Successively.'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the 3rd paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

" 'Section 1. The treasurer shall be chosen biennially, at the first session of the legislature, by joint ballot of the senators, and representatives in convention, ~~but shall not be eligible more than six years successively.~~ "

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the 3rd paragraph from the end and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

"Shall the constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the legislature to remove the provision that the treasurer shall not be eligible more than 6 years successively?"
