This analysis is provided as a look at the potential aggregate resources available for local governmental spending after projections of educational expenditures assuming that property tax commitment grows at a fixed 3% growth rate. This analysis shows that the additional educational spending and other local resources provide aggregate residual resources for other non-educational expenditures of local governments that growth by approximately 5% per year in fiscal year 2007, 2008 and 2009.
