

§2923-C. Cost reporting

1. Reporting requirements. Annually, on a date prescribed by the bureau by rule, a public safety answering point and dispatch center shall each provide the bureau with a report of the costs incurred by the public safety answering point or dispatch center for the provision of enhanced 9-1-1 services. 2. Rules. The bureau shall adopt rules to implement this section. The rules must establish requirements for the report provided by a public safety answering point and dispatch center pursuant to subsection 1, including, at a minimum:

A. The manner by which the report must be submitted to the bureau; [PL 2023, c. 609, §3 (NEW).]

B. The specific cost components for the provision of enhanced 9-1-1 services to be included in the report; and [PL 2023, c. 609, §3 (NEW).]

C. The date by which the report must be submitted. [PL 2023, c. 609, §3 (NEW).]

Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
