§18211. Board of licensure for professional land surveyors

1. Establishment. The Board of Licensure for Professional Land Surveyors is established within the department pursuant to Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 21 to carry out the purposes of this chapter.

- **2. Members.** The board consists of 7 members appointed by the Governor. Each member must be a resident of this State. The board consists of:
 - A. Two public members as defined in Title 5, section 12004-A; and [PL 2013, c. 180, §5 (NEW); PL 2013, c. 180, §6 (AFF).]
 - B. Five members who hold valid professional land surveyor licenses and have been licensed as professional land surveyors for at least 10 years immediately prior to appointment to the board. [PL 2013, c. 180, §5 (NEW); PL 2013, c. 180, §6 (AFF).]

- **3. Terms; removal.** Terms of the members of the board are for 5 years. Appointments of members must comply with Title 10, section 8009. Members may be removed by the Governor for cause. [PL 2013, c. 180, §5 (NEW); PL 2013, c. 180, §6 (AFF).]
- **4. Meetings; chair.** The board shall meet at least once a year to conduct its business and to elect a chair. Additional meetings must be held as necessary to conduct the business of the board and may be convened at the call of the chair or a majority of the board members.
