# An Act To Change the Name of the Division of Labor Market Information Services to the Center for Workforce Research and Information

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1401-A, sub-§2, ¶F, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 560, Pt. G, §15, is amended to read:

F. The <u>Division of Labor Market Information ServicesCenter for Workforce Research and</u> Information;

Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §2031, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 665, Pt. DD, §5 and affected by §12, is amended to read:

**3. Interdepartmental review team.** An application for funding under the program must be reviewed by an interdepartmental review team. The review team consists of 2 representatives from the Department of Labor, one of whom must be from the Division of Labor Market Information ServicesCenter for Workforce Research and Information, and 2 representatives from the Department of Economic and Community Development.
