§3853. Insuring powers of reciprocals

1. A reciprocal insurer may, upon qualifying therefore as provided for by this Title, transact any kind or kinds of insurance defined by this Title, other than life or title insurances. [PL 1969, c. 132, §1 (NEW).]

2. Such an insurer may purchase reinsurance upon the risk of any subscriber, and may grant reinsurance as to any kind of insurance it is authorized to transact direct.
