**COMMITTEE AMENDMENT TO LD 125, AN ACT TO PROHIBIT AERIAL
SPRAYING OF GLYPHOSATE AND OTHER SYNTHETIC HERBICIDES FOR THE
PURPOSE OF SILVICULTURE**

Amend the bill in section 1 as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §606, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Aerial spraying of glyphosate and other synthetic herbicides. A person may not conduct an aerial application of glyphosate or other synthetic herbicides for the purpose of silviculture, including reforestation, regeneration or vegetation control after any timber harvest, including but not limited to a timber harvesting activity conducted in accordance with Title 12, chapter 805, subchapter 3-A.

Amend the bill by striking out sections 2 and 3 of the bill.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the prohibition on aerial application of glyphosate or other synthetic herbicides for the purpose of silviculture also applies to a timber harvesting activity conducted in accordance with the Forest Practices Act.
