The Maine public is listening to enormously costly false advertising paid for by Canadian public agency Hydro Quebec - misstating effect of the power line project on the environment. The Maine people cannot afford to advertise the truth to counteract these prevarications

Because .Bureau of Public Lands currently doesn't have process or rules to determine if a project meets the "substantially altered" criteria 2 administrations issued leases to CMP without Legislative vote

Justice in Maine Court found that the Bureau did not properly identify if CMP Corridor to Canada would substantially reduce or alter value of public lands before issuing leases to CMP.

Establishing rules will ensure that the Maine Constitution is upheld, and that the same standards are applied to leases or sales involving our public lands, regardless of who is in power.

2/3 of Legislature sales or leases require reduce or alter substantially land held in public trust value , Mainers amended the Maine Constitution In 1993 to protect Maine's public lands

to ensure openness and transparency, it's essential to pass LD 1075.
