To the chairs and members of the ACF Committee:

This bill would establish a uniform set of rules for all public land leases and sales. The Bureau of Public Lands does not now have a process or rules in place to determine if a project meets "substantially altered" criteria. There's a problem when a phrase such as "substantially altered" is used in statute or in rules as a criterion for a project without a definition of "substantially altered", which can mean different things to different people and different administrations. I believe voting "ought to pass" on LD 1075 would great increase openness and transparency in how our public lands are treated. Please vote OTP on LD 1075.
