# **Forest Action Plan Process**

### On-line survey

- Conducted 10 December 2019 15 January 2020
- Announcement put out on MFS listservs, MFS website, and forwarded to major organizations (NRCM, MFPC, Maine Woodland Owners, Project Canopy Leadership Team, Forest Legacy Committee, DIFW, Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee, NRCS State Technical Committee, Maine Audubon, US Forest Service, Certified Logging Professional Program, Professional Logging Contractors, tribal forestry contacts, and Maine Tree Farm Committee (also reforwarded to COG's and Regional Planning Commissions, Maine Coast Heritage Trust, and Local Wood Works, there may have been others). In short, the announcement was distributed to hundreds of people across the state.
- Received 319 responses, which helped guide drafting.
