The United States Undetectable Firearms Act of 1988

General effect of this legislation is a ban on the manufacture, possession and transfer of firearms with less than 3.7 oz (105 g) of metal content. The bill also requires handguns to be in the traditional shape of a handgun. So why does Maine need it's own law?
