

Testimony of Lauren Stewart

IN SUPPORT OF LD 1313 AS AMENDED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY WHO SIGNS AND SWEARS TO A CERTIFICATE STATING THE RESULTS OF A BREATH-ALCOHOL TEST
