I grew up in South Portland and became conscious of the harm being done in Long Creek when I was thirteen. My peers who were spending time in Long Creek were being harmed, stigmatized, and left unsupported by South Portland School Department and the greater community. The 18.6 million dollars the state spends on incarcerating youth should absolutely be reinvested into a comprehensive support network that properly addresses the lack of resources available to our youth. This community has a profound opportunity to send a message to our youth that we are listening to their trauma and needs, we are unconditionally rooting for them, and they are always deserving of care.

LD 1668 has the potential to positively impact our community at large. We will all be safer and more supported when our most vulnerable are safe and supported. Long Creek sends harm rippling through our community. LD 1668 will give hope and impact that will ripple far beyond this community.
