Dear Senator Beebe-Center, Representative Salisbury, and members of the Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee,

My name is Kenneth Drake Jr. and I am writing in support of LD 178.

Though I personally would not benefit from the passage of this bill, I believe that there are many people incarcerated at Maine State Prison and other MDOC facilities who could be safely released on parole. Over the 13 months I have been at MSP, I've met people who are truly remorseful and repentant of their crimes. A lot of these men are active in recovery, supportive to their fellow prisoners. Some also have earned degrees or are in college, and most are employed or volunteering in one or more programs.

There are many men here who deserve another chance, men who by their deeds while incarcerated show they want to change for the better, restore their relationships with their families and communities, and live a worthwhile life.

Admittedly, there are some prisoners who won't deserve parole or can't be safely released, but I believe parole should be an option for some prisoners, prisoners with good behavior, prisoners who have been active in their rehabilitation, and those who would support their families.
