Testimony in Opposition to LD 22

An Act to Impede the Transfer of Firearms to Prohibited Persons

Senator Beebe-Center, Representative Salisbury, and members of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety:

My name is Nathan Gould. I am from Winterport. I am giving this testimony in opposition to LD 22, "An Act to Impede the Transfer of Firearms to Prohibited Persons."

Laws designed to prevent criminals from gaining access to firearms already exist—they are already "prohibited persons". The law proposed in LD 22 is redundant and does not increase safety. Those with the intent to break the law will do so, whether the crime be illegally acquiring the firearm or using the firearm to commit a crime.

Rather, current laws should be enforced, and law enforcement should be supported to that end. This bill treads too close to the precarious edge of infringing upon our Second Amendment rights.
