Dear members of Maine's Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs, Please support LDs 51, 869, 1098, 1148, 1209 and 1228 this session. These bills would restore religious and philosophical

exemptions to vaccines and prevent COVID-19 vaccination requirements in Maine's public and private school systems, protecting education access for all children in Maine. Maine and national public health officials lied and misled the public during the COVID-19
