This bill, if passed, would alleviate potential problems facing the Lucerne-in-Maine Corporation within the Town of Dedham. This bill also has a practical, political aspect. Without the repeal of this law, many property owners on Phillips Lake might risk loss of value to their shorefront property. This law as written could ruin their beaches if it were ever enforced.
