I urge you to vote "ought to pass" on LD 1498: An Act To Prevent Increased Heating Fuel, Natural Gas, Gasoline and Diesel Fuel.

Maine is both an old and a cold State. Nearly 21% of Maine's population is over age 65, and it Maine maintains the oldest median age in the country at 44.9 years.
