GrowSmart Maine in support of LD 1616 "An Act To Enhance the Ability of Municipalities to Address Climate Change Impacts by Protecting and Restoring Threatened Natural Resources"

Senator Brenner, Representative Tucker, and members of the Joint Standing Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, my name is Nancy Smith and I am the Executive Director of GrowSmart Maine.

We are a statewide non-partisan organization that supports communities as they navigate change in alignment with smart growth.
