RE: L.D. 998, An Act To Amend the Continuing Education Requirement for Pharmacists

Dear Senator Sanborn, Representative Tepler, and Members of the Committee:

The Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation is neither for nor against L.D. 998, *An Act To Amend the Continuing Education Requirement for Pharmacists*. Current law requires all pharmacists to complete 15 hours of board-approved continuing professional education. At least two (2) of the total fifteen (15) hours must consist of board-approved courses on drug administration – regardless of whether the pharmacist has obtained the required certification to administer drugs and vaccines pursuant to Title 32, subchapter 13 ("ADV certification").

This bill clarifies that *only* a pharmacist with ADV certification is required to complete 2 hours of continuing professional education on drug administration. While all pharmacists still must comply with the 15 hours of continuing education, L.D. 998 provides that those pharmacists without ADV certification will be permitted to refocus those 2 hours to a more relevant practice area for that pharmacist.

Currently, of the 2,313 pharmacists licensed by the Board of Pharmacy, 1,332 have the ADV certification.
