I am writing on behalf of Northeast Pharmacy Service Corporation (NPSC) in support of LD 1450. This bill will give Maine patients greater authority over their healthcare decisions by protecting them from misleading pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) communications.

NPSC works on behalf of nearly 300 independent community pharmacies in the Northeast.

Patients are easily steered by both the content and the context (i.e. logos) of communication. Whenever patients have a choice of pharmacy, it should be required that it be made "crystal clear" to the cardholder. In this way, patients are afforded their right to choose the provider they work with most closely in the interest of their best health. The PBM's financial interests are not always aligned with the patients; best health.
