As Executive Director of COLAGE, a national nonprofit dedicated to the children of LGBTQ+ families, I am testifying in support of LD 1539, An Act to Provide Access to Fertility Care.

For thirty years, COLAGE has been the only national organization expressly dedicated to supporting people with one or more LGBTQ+ caregivers and uniting them with a network of peers. We support them as they nurture and empower each other to be skilled, self-confident, and just leaders in their communities. We are committed to bringing about a world where children of LGBTQ+ parents are legally secure, respected and valued for who they are.

COLAGE is grateful that LD 1539 is written in an inclusive way, which will improve access to fertility care for LGBTQ+ individuals and couples who seek fertility treatment to try to become parents. For many prospective LGBTQ+ parents, access to fertility treatments is a significant factor in determining where to live and begin building their families. According to a survey conducted by Family Equality in 2019, roughly 63% of LGBTQ+ millennials expect to use assisted reproductive technology when expanding their families, making the implementation of LD 1539 an imperitive for future LGBTQ+ families in Maine.
