The healthcare system is not optimized for positive patient outcomes, nor is it integrated into public health overall.

By supporting this legislation, we will move closer to eliminating the multiple insurance regulations that hamper more efficient healthcare practices and be positioned to provide greater community involvement that can make a difference for citizens of the state of Maine.
