As well, the medical treatments referenced in this bill are so complex and life altering that allowing such to happen without proper consent, involvement of parents and having a support system in place will further place our younger and most vulnerable kids at extreme risk beyond what is obvious and take healthcare backwards in barbaric ways that cause me to have grave concerns. I could expand on my thoughts regarding this bill and with my years of experience in hospital and community healthcare continue to have grave concerns in regards to the great risk that this legislation poses for our children.
